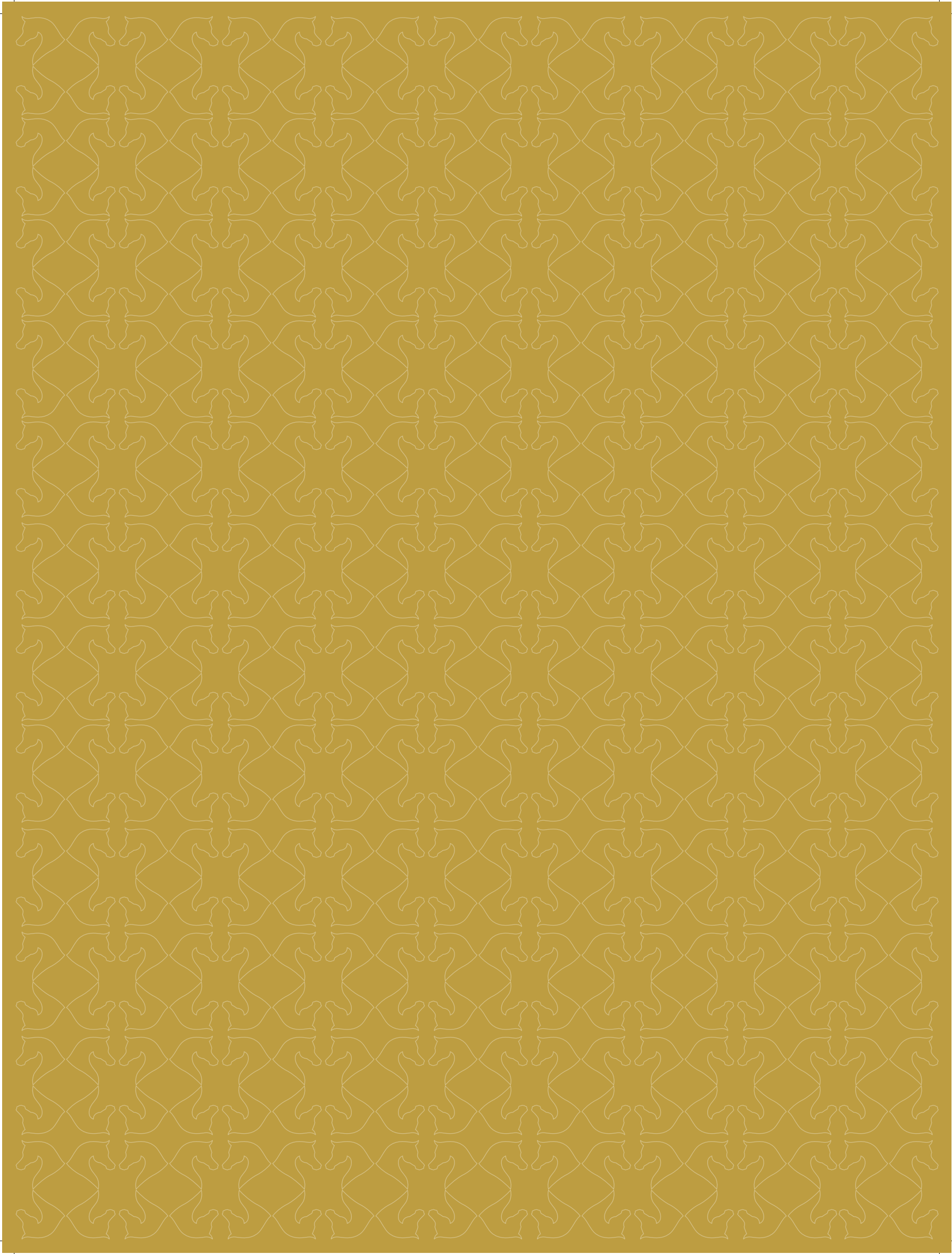

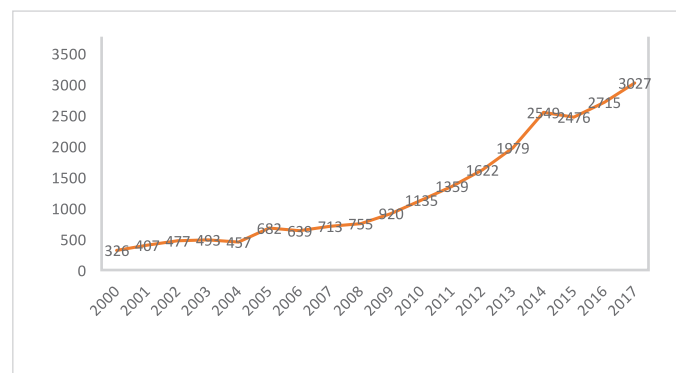

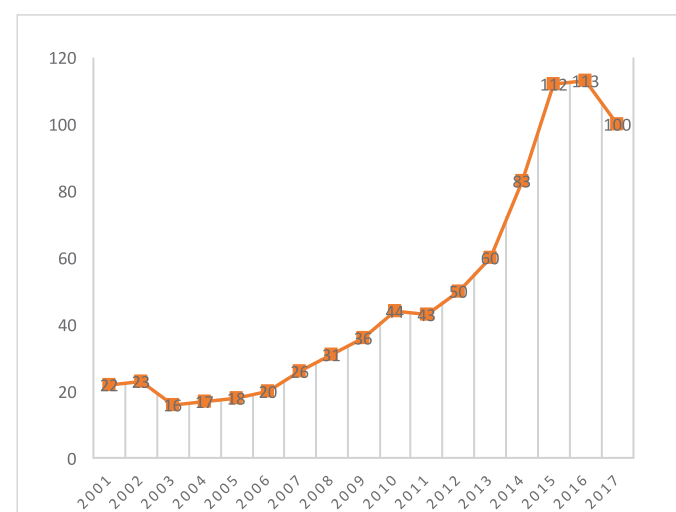
Endurance Riding is a Competition to test the Athlete's ability to safely manage the stamina and fitness of the Horse over an endurance course in a Competition against the track, the distance, the climate, the terrain and the clock.

Endurance Events acclaim a particular position in the United Arab Emirates because of the great support of their Highnesses the Sheikhs. In the early nineties of the last century, the United Arab Emirates stepped into the field of equestrian sport and endurance, and is now one of the most important countries in the world, even the leader in the field of this sport, at the local, regional and global levels, and has scored out many achievements and, further, it has also endeavored to spread this sport in various countries across the world. It organized and supported many international events in these countries, which contributed to the development of the sport at the local and international levels. Now, the Endurance is a national sport in the United Arab Emirates, as we see the increasing turnout for this sport as described in the report, which reviews the most important achievements during the 2016 / 2017 and 2017 / 2018 seasons and the development of the sport as follows:

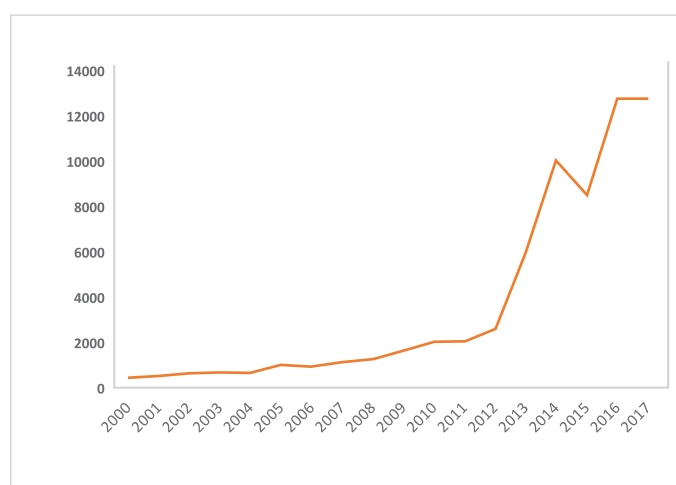

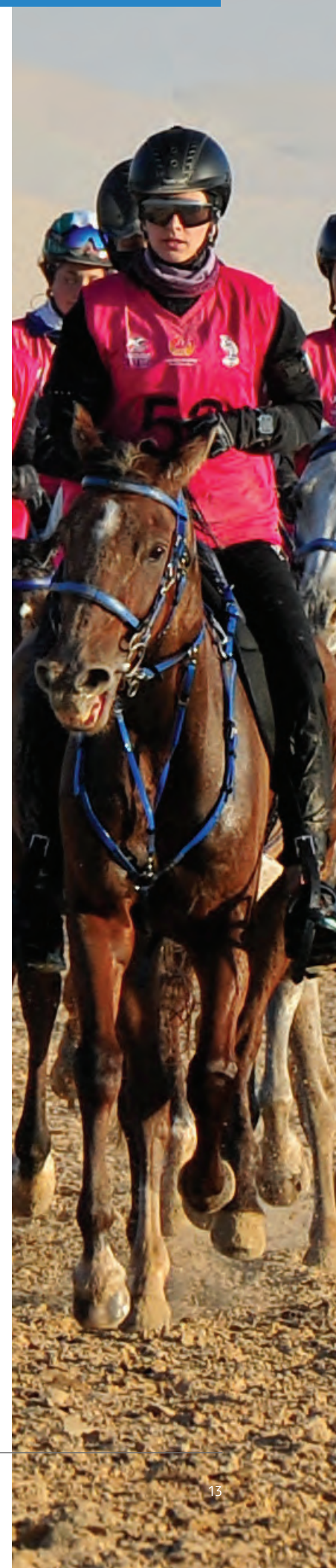

The Achievements of Jumping Section

Jumping

Jumping is one of the disciplines of the equestrian sport in which the ability of horses to jump and rider skill is tested by overcoming many different obstacles, and the winner is the one who finishes the competition in the least penalties and the fastest time.

Jumping competitions are divided into three sections:

1. Time Competition
2. Penalties competition
3. Special competitions

Achievements of the Jumping Section Season 2017\2018

- Before the season started the jumping committee modified the national general rules and condition to be more flexible and easier for all riders to achieve better results.
- Registration of 343 riders and 590 horses.
- Organize 19 national competition and 3 finals which are:
 - Local riders
 - Longines final
 - Young horse's final (introduced for the first time)
- Organize more than 10 international shows such as CSI1*, CSI2*, CSI3*, CSI4*, CSI5*, CSI L2*, CSI YH, and CSI Y.J.CH
- The biggest show is the President Cup CSI05*, the qualifier for the CSIO final in Barcelona.
- Organize summer camp to prepare the national teams; senior, young riders, and junior children for the coming competitions
- Qualifying the first team through the international competitions that was held in the UAE to the WEG in Tryon USA 2018.
- Participation in the Asian games in Jakarta 2018
- Qualifying one rider from the junior riders to FEI challenge final in Uzbekistan 2018

- Qualifying one rider from the young riders to the Youth Olympic games that will be held in Buenos Aires -Argentina in October 2018
- Qualifying the young rider team to the final with European teams in Belgium throughout group 7 final 2018

Note: in 2017 the UAE senior team won the Challenge Cup in the Nation Cup in Barcelona. The team was consisting of the following riders:

The Jumping section paid special attention to qualify more national resources for the stewarding and judging under the patronage of UAE Equestrian and Racing Federation.

The section also organized two seminars as follow:

1. Refreshment seminar for judges from all levels with attendance of 15 participants
2. For qualifiers and level 1 stewarding with attendance of 14 participants.

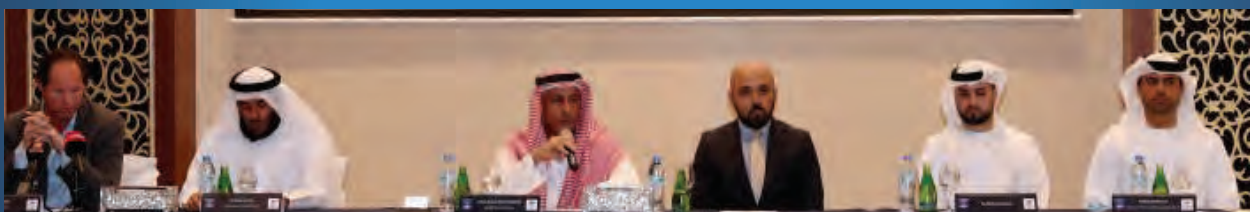

Tent Pegging World Cup Abu Dhabi 2018

Last year's equestrian season begins with a unique event. It was the 2018 Tent Pegging World Cup in Abu Dhabi. The UAE is hosting this event for the first time in the history because of its leadership in the equestrian sports and sponsoring the old Arabic international sport.

His Excellency General Dr. Ahmed Nasser Al Raisi, President of the UAE Equestrian and racing Federation, and the Senior Management, have sought the opportunity of the UAE to host the World Cup after the offer of several countries to host the unique event. He also called for overcoming all obstacles for the participants and competitors from around the world. And to make the visit to Abu Dhabi the equestrian capital of the world unforgettable.

About Tent Pegging



Tent Pegging is one of the oldest equestrian sports where the rider uses the sword or spear, while riding at speed to hit a very small target. The rider needs to be physically fit, be mentally focused, be an accomplished horseman and have excellent hand-eye coordination.

It is imperative that the rider focuses on the tiny target which must be punctured or cut by the spear or sword.

Tent pegging mounts must be fast, agile and brave horses. They must be highly trained to ignore the weapons used by the rider and must gallop straight and fast towards the target.

The sport of Tent Pegging is found in many countries across the world. Riders can use any type of trained horses and usually compete on animals local to the country, with championships providing horses for competitors. Each team consists of five riders; four primary and one reserve rider.

The International Federation of Tent Pegging was announced in the last quarter of 2013, and United Arab Emirates was one of the countries that joined the Federation at the time of establishment. Despite this relatively short period, more than 35 countries have joined the Federation, with the headquarters located in the Sultanate of Oman.

Oman has hosted the first world championship in 2014, where the South Africa team won the World cup. The second championship was held in 2016, hosted by Egypt, who consequently scored a home win in the competition's second year.

For the first time in United Arab Emirates, Abu Dhabi will host the Tent Pegging World Cup in its third edition, bringing together 12 countries. The International Federation of Tent Pegging seeks to make this traditional equestrian discipline an Olympic sport.

ABOUT DRESSAGE

Dressage is a French term, most commonly translated to mean ("training") is a highly skilled form of riding performed in exhibition and competition, as well as an "art" sometimes pursued solely for the sake of mastery. As an Equestrian sport defined by the International Equestrian Federation, dressage is "the highest expression of "horse training" where "horse and rider are expected to perform from memory a series of predetermined movements."

Competitions are held at all levels from amateur to the Olympic Games and the World Equestrian Games. Its fundamental purpose is to develop, through standardized progressive training methods, a horse's natural athletic ability and willingness to perform, thereby maximizing its potential as a riding horse. At the peak of a dressage horse's gymnastic development, the horse responds smoothly to a skilled rider's minimal aids. The rider is relaxed and appears effort-free while the horse willingly performs the requested movement.

The discipline has a rich history with ancient roots in the writings of Xenophon. Modern dressage has evolved as an important equestrian pursuit since the Renaissance when Federico Grisone's "The Rules of Riding" was published in 1550, the first treatise on equitation in over a thousand years since Xenophon's On Horsemanship. Much about training systems used today reflects practices of classical dressage.

In modern dressage competition, successful training at the various levels is demonstrated through the performance of "tests", prescribed series of movements ridden within a standard arena. Judges evaluate each movement on the basis of an objective standard appropriate to the level of the test and assign each movement a score from zero to ten - zero being "not executed" and 10 being "excellent". A score of 9 is very good and is a high mark, while a competitor achieving all 6s (or 60% overall) should be considering moving on to the next level.

Dressage in the UAE became an affiliated discipline under the UAEERF in 2013. This season it is expected that the number of registered riders will approach 200. In March of 2019 the UAE plans to host the first FEI International Dressage Show. The UAE calendar of Dressage Shows continues to grow and may surpass 22 competitions this season.

Long-term, under the wise guidance of the UAE Olympic Committee, the UAE's Sports Councils and the UAEERF Executive Board, it is expected that the UAE will compete in the next World Equestrian Games and onwards seek Olympic qualification.

The UAE will again benefit this season from the continued support of foreign Dressage experts. These professionals regularly visit the country conducting clinics and symposiums which support the development of Dressage in the country.

ABOUT EVENTING

Eventing (also known as three day eventing or horse trials) is an equestrian event where a single horse and rider combination compete against other combinations across the three disciplines of dressage, cross-country and show jumping. This event has its roots in a comprehensive Cavalry test which required mastery of several types of riding.

The competition may be run as a one-day event (ODE), where all three events are completed in one day (dressage, followed by show jumping then the cross country phase) or a three-day event (3DE), which is more commonly now run over four days, with dressage on the first two days followed by cross country the next day and then show jumping in reverse order on the final day. Eventing was previously known as Combined Training, and the name persists in many smaller organizations. The term "Combined Training" is sometimes confused with the term "Combined Test" which refers to a combination of just two of the phases, most commonly dressage and show jumping.

The next phase, cross-country, requires both horse and rider to be in excellent physical shape and to be brave and trusting of each other. This phase consists of approximately 12–20 fences (lower levels), or 30–40 at the higher levels, placed on a long outdoor circuit. These fences consist of very solidly built natural objects (logs, stone walls, etc.) as well as various obstacles such as ponds and streams, ditches, drops and banks, and combinations including several jumping efforts based on objects that would commonly occur in the countryside. Sometimes, particularly at higher levels, fences are designed that would not normally occur in nature. However, these are still designed to be as solid as more natural obstacles. Safety regulations mean that some obstacles are now being built with a "frangible pin system", allowing part or all of the jump to collapse if hit with enough impact.

Speed is also a factor, with the rider required to cross the finish line within a certain time frame (optimum time). Crossing the finish line after the optimum time results in penalties for each second over. At lower levels, there is also a speed fault time, where penalties are incurred for horse and rider pairs completing the course too quickly.

For every "disobedience" (refusal or run-out of a jump) a horse and rider incur on course, penalties will be added to their dressage score. After four disobediences altogether or three disobediences at one fence the pair is eliminated, meaning they can no longer participate in the competition. A horse and rider pair can also be eliminated for going off course, for example missing a fence. If the horse's shoulder and hind-quarter touch the ground, mandatory retirement is taken and they are not allowed to participate further in the competition.

If the rider falls off the horse they are eliminated. However, in the US this rule is currently being revised for the Novice level and below. The penalties for disobediences on cross country are weighted severely relative to the other phases of competition to emphasize the importance of courage, endurance and athleticism. Fitness is required as the time allowed will require a strong canter at the lower levels, all the way to a strong gallop at the higher events.

Eventing in the UAE was recognized in 2015 by the UAEERF. Since then the sport has grown in stature and this season the UAE will host 12 ODE or Horse Trials across the country. In March 2019, the UAE will host its first FEI International ODE at Desert Palm Polo Club in Dubai. The UAEERF is committed to sending an Eventing Team to future Asian Games, World Equestrian Games and ultimately the Olympic Games.

Accomplishments of the Veterinary Section Season 2017 – 2018

The Veterinary Section in the UAE Federation is the central point of all equestrian sports in general. The Veterinary Section of the Federation has an active and varied role to play in safeguarding the welfare of the equine sporting industry. The Section has the responsibility to ensure that those involved in national and international equestrian sport adhere to the rules and regulations binding the sports and accept at all times that the welfare of the horse is paramount.

Here we furnish the accomplishments of the section during the season.

The Veterinary Section was very active during the season 2017 – 2018 by:

- Providing veterinary coverage during all sporting events both within the UAE and whenever called for in overseas centers for the sports disciplines such as Endurance, Show Jumping, Dressage, Eventing and Racing.
- The section was active, supervising and ensuring that all the sports rules are observed by the officials and OCs during the events held in and around the UAE as the welfare of the horse is paramount in all equestrian sports.
- Carried out and supervised the Medication Control Program during all the equestrian events which involves drawing blood and urine samples randomly and as predestined during the competitions and sending the same to the designated international laboratories, and on receipt of results carrying out further proceedings as per the required protocol.
- The section dealt with all the Positive Cases in different equestrian disciplines in accordance with the Medication and Anti-doping programme against banned and controlled substances, mediating between the Persons Responsible and the Federation Equestre Internationale (FEI), assisting in the fair judgement of the cases.
- The Head of the Veterinary Section Dr. Ali Twessi was designated by the FEI to various international competitions in countries such as Portugal, Jordan, Turkmenistan, Britain.

An FEI forum was held in April 2018 on 7th and 8th – a joint effort of FEI and UAEERF which turned out to be great success.

Working with the Disciplinary Committee: -

- UAE Equestrian and Racing Federation formed a Disciplinary Committee in order to address various cases in the events and to issue penalties accordingly. The Veterinary department's active participation was there by providing veterinary assistance in the entire procedures by giving reports and suggestions to the committee to facilitate fair judgement of individual cases.
- Veterinary Section actively played a big role inhouse, catering to the needs of the customers/clients which included:
 - i) Catering to the needs of the public clients by answering to the telephone enquiries with regard to various issues and rules binding the various sports, and procedures involved in various horse related documentations.
 - ii) Attending to the needs of the Walk-in clients and serving them to their maximum satisfaction.



iii) Updating the clubs/stables, and related horse population from time to time with regard to the amendments and changes to the rules and procedures via e-mails and circulars/memos etc.

iv) Regular general correspondence with the clients via e-mails and faxes services, regular dispatching of the documents/ passports etc. by courier services etc. to the clients

v) worked jointly with offices like **Ministries, other National Federations (NFs), Shipping Companies, Higher Technical Committee, Clubs/ Stables, equine hospitals and related establishments** in routine manner in a regular fashion as a part of the veterinary requirements of the sports.

vi) Actively worked with the **American University** in the United Arab Emirates by participating in their various educational programmes by providing information on **equestrian management**.

vii) The section closely supervised the veterinarians registered under the Federation in their various activities during the events guiding them through to maintain their star status and promoting the qualified ones to the next levels.
