



LOWERING CO₂ EMISSIONS



Solar street lamps: 300 solar street lamps installed on the 2 500 m on the start line



Fewer vehicles:

A drastic cut from 1000 cars to just 250 on the field of play

- 1 car per competitor
- Officials, media, and organisers: hybrid vehicles and collective transport where possible



Shuttle buses:

Regular shuttles to and from hotel accommodation.





PLASTIC FREE

Water: replacing the use of 500 000 bottles by 3 litre buckets to be used for cooling the horses



Recycling bins throughout the site and waste recycled through the appropriate channels



Biodegradeable cutlery:
No plastic cutlery will be used on site



SAVING WATER



Butheeb hotel area: dispensers to reduce plastic pollution



Cooling area:
Desalinated water recycled for nature





Main water points:
Reducing bottles. Water
available in buckets from
big troughs



SUSTAINABLE FOOD



Local food:

All the organiser's dining and catering points on site will be, as far as possible, supplied by local farms.

Bio-waste to be recycled

Food donation

Any surplus food to be donated to a local cause, the Emirates red crescent
