


1.	AXC C	Enter in trot (without halt) Track to the right	Straightness and precision of the centre line.
2.	CMBXEK	Trot	Accuracy and precision of lines. Correct execution of the corner.
3.	KAF FXH HC	Trot Change rein on the diagonal Trot	Precision and straightness of the diagonal. Correct execution of corners.
4.	Between C&M ME EF	Transition to walk Walk Walk	Quality of transition. Correct execution of the corner. Precision and straightness of the short diagonals.
5.	Between F&A AKEXBM	Transition to trot Trot	Quality of transition. Accuracy and precision of lines. Correct execution of the corner.
6.	MCH HXF F(A)	Trot Change rein on the diagonal Trot	Precision and straightness of the diagonal. Correct execution of the corner.
7.	Between F&A A AXG	Transition to walk Down the center line Walk on the center line	Quality of transition. Correctness and precision of the line. Straightness.
8.	G	Halt – immobility - salute	Transition into halt. Straightness, immobility (min 3 sec)
Leave arena at A in walk on a long rein

Assessment of individual tasks	Commentary	Mark
<u>Rider's position and seat</u> Seat: well balanced, elastic, in centre of saddle; Correct position of upper body, arm, elbow, hand, leg, heel.		
<u>Effectiveness of aids</u> Influence of aids on accurate presentation of movements, transitions. Sensitive and relatively invisible use of aids. Independence of rider's seat from the reins.		
<u>Precision</u> Preparation of movements. Accuracy of execution of figures on correct lines and prescribed markers. Going into the corners. Correct bend and straightness where required.		
<u>Harmony</u> Willingness of the horse to cooperate, attention and confidence. Absence of resistance and miscommunication.		
<u>General impression</u> The appearance of the rider and the horse and the ability of the rider to present the horse favorably.
